Become an integral part of the movement across Salem County to bring environmental awareness and activities right into the classrooms of county schools.

Through a sequence of workshops over a year, teachers will learn about environmental issues, how they can be applied to their classroom and how their schools can be *Going Green* with students assessing whether their school is accomplishing their goals.

One or more teachers from each school in the county are welcomed to attend. At the first meeting, teachers will also help to develop details of their own program and learn how to conduct Green Audits of conditions and behavior. For example, a teacher may choose to have the class perform a weekly audit of environmental behaviors, like turning off lights when the room is not in use.



The ongoing progress of each school will be published on the project website on the Mannington Mills domain. Mannington Mills will also provide professional development and mentors from the plant to work with teachers in the *Going Green* effort.

Play a role in an exciting county-wide project in collaboration with Mannington Mills and colleagues in county schools to make a difference with students, parents, and entire schools in how they view and interact with the world around them.
