This is the second in a sequence of workshops over a year designed to help teachers learn about environmental issues, how they can be applied to their classroom and how their schools can be **Going Green** with students assessing whether their school is accomplishing their goals.

At this meeting, teachers will help to finalize details of their own program. They will also share ideas, and activities with colleagues engaged in the program as well as with Mannington Mills environmental experts. In small groups, teachers will develop individual implementation plans and measurement systems to determine the progress of their class in **Going Green** for the next school year.

- A system for auditing raw data connected to their selected actions and issues.
- A format and forms for collecting and analyzing data connected to that monitoring work.
- A process for ensuring their data is communicated to project leaders for inclusion on the *Going Green* website.
- Dates for future sessions in the **Going Green** Teacher Workshop series.
